2024 GCFM ANNUAL MEETING REPORT

More than 230 Garden Club Members attended the 97th GCFM Annual Meeting that was held on Thursday, June 13th, at the Doubletree Hotel Ballroom in Andover, Massachusetts.

Awards:

Thirty-five (35) state awards were presented to numerous garden clubs for their achievements in Massachusetts. On a regional level, five (5) awards were given by the New England Garden Clubs, while fifteen (15) awards were granted by the National Garden Clubs.

Scholarships:

Eleven (11) GCFM scholarships for \$1,000 each were awarded, while five (5) of nine possible Helen Freidberg scholarships were awarded. Two (2) NGC scholarships for \$4,000 were awarded.

Youth Poetry Contests:

Six (6) GCFM winners were announced, with two (2) of those individuals taking home a national prize.

Miscellaneous:

Five (5) clubs celebrated landmark anniversaries.


